DESCRIPTION:

- Put on your hats of creativity, get ready to dirty your hands and let the Battle of JUNKY begin!!

ABOUT THE EVENT

The participants will be given random scrap material (the only inventory) out of which you have to build a working model (machine) which can perform the specified task. It's a test of your dexterity and intuitive thought process. The competition aims to test how one quick and creative one can be at the same time and solve a problem. That's Junkyard Wards is about.

EVENT STRUCTURE:-

- The event will consist of a preliminary elimination round followed by the main event.
- Everyone has to report at the venue 30 minutes before the commencement of the preliminary elimination round.

Preliminary Elimination Round:-There will be a quiz (*may subject to change*) which may contain both objective and subjective questions. The questions will test the student's

engineering aptitude and to make understand its significance. The duration of the quiz will be a 1 hour. Only 6(*may subject to change*) teams will be selected for the main event.

Main Event:- The selected teams will be given 4hrs (duration may subject to change if the organising body decides so) to work out their innovations and build a perfect solution to the given problem in the given time and resources. The problem statement will be mentioned on the spot.

RULES AND REGULATION:

- 1. Students from different institutes can form a team.
 - 2. A team may consist of 2 to 4 members.
 - 3. Every participant must get himself/herself registered before the event begins.
 - 4. For eliminations, teams have to appear for a test as single entity. Each team will be given 1 question paper and 1 answer sheet along with rough sheet.
 - 5. Marks of the preliminary round will not be carried to the main event.
 - 6. Use of any parts or instruments other than provided by the organizers is prohibited.
 - 7. Time for the 2nd round will start soon after the task to be performed is declared.
 - 8. Each team must formulate their own ideas and designs. Any form of plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
 - 9. There will be no restriction on the type of mechanism used by the team to perform the task provided no other rule is violated.
 - 10. No extra time will be given to any team under any circumstances.
 - 11. Organizers are not responsible for any loss of property, injury and delays during the event.
 - 12. Judge's decision will be final and binding on all.
 - 13. The team must adhere to the team spirit & accomplish a healthy competition.
 - 14. Any negligence/fraud on the part of the participating team, once detected, will lead to immediate disqualification.

- 15. Organizers reserve the right to change any number of rule and the team must abide to it.
- 16. Participation certificates will be provided to all the participants.
- 17. Participants are required to stay up to date with the website.
